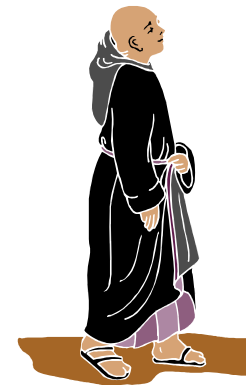

# Christianity

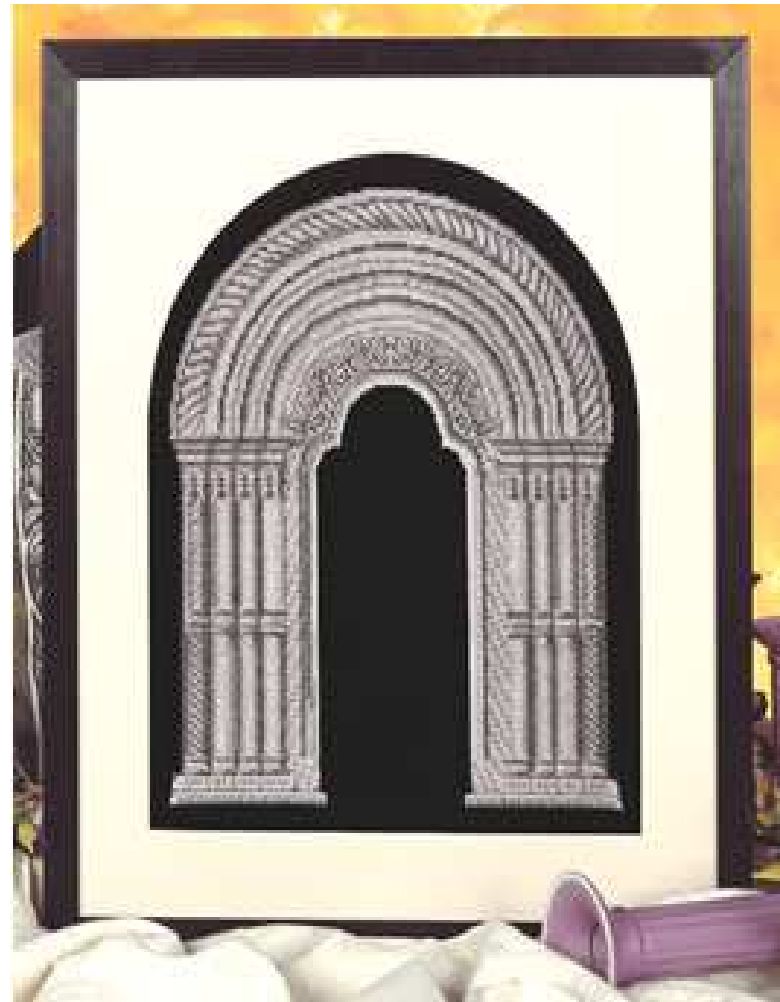
- In The Middle Ages most people were Christian. The leader was the pope in Rome.

- Inside was dark



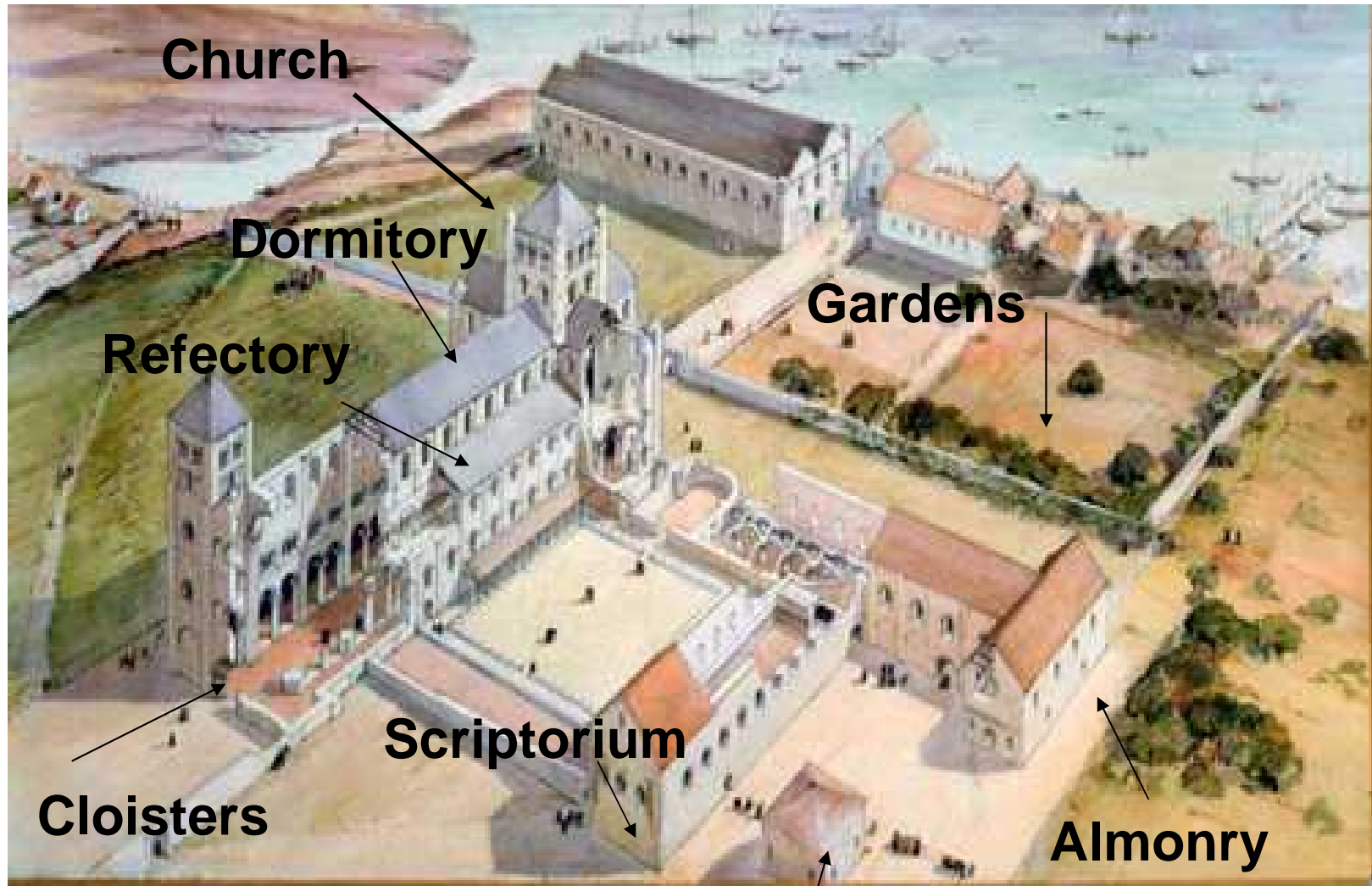
# Gothic
