Results of the Plantation

The plantation changed Ulster in many ways. It was the most Irish part of the country and changed to being where the English had the strongest hold.

- 1. As the Irish got the worst land and had to pay high rent they remained very unhappy.
- 2. Gaelic culture was replaced by English culture such as speaking English and changing from cattle farming to crop growing.
- 3. A rebellion in 1641 saw thousands of planters massacred
- 4. The divisions between the Gaelic Catholic Irish and the Scottish and English protestant planters can still be felt today.
